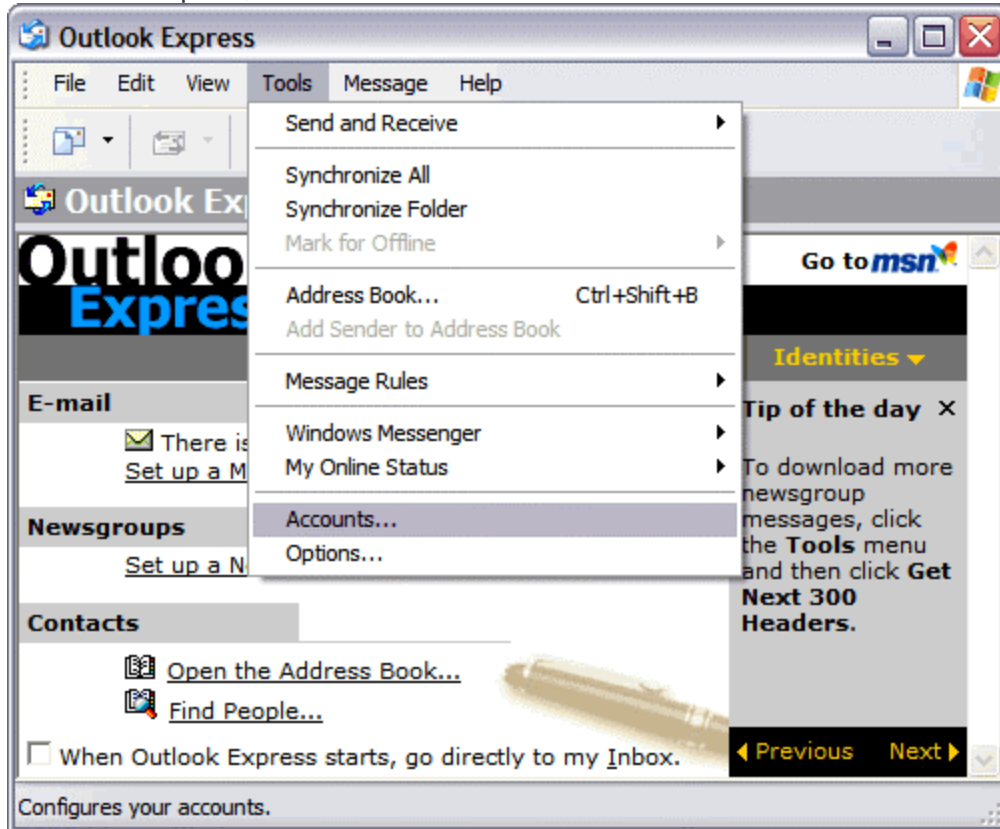
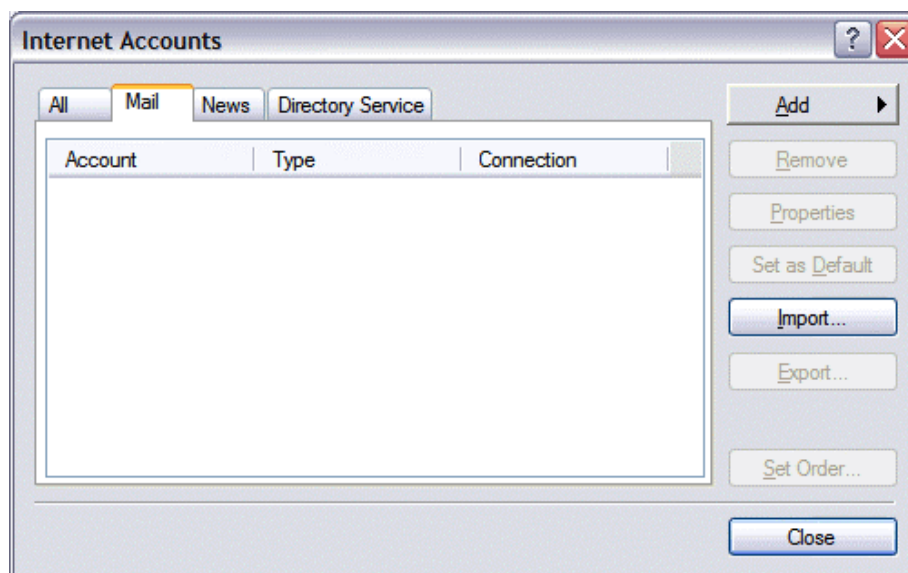


SETTING UP AN EMAIL ADDRESS USING OUTLOOK EXPRESS


1. Open Outlook Express
2. In Microsoft Outlook Express, select Tools > Accounts.



3. Select the "Mail" tab in the Internet Accounts window and click "Add."



4. Enter your full name and click Next.


When you send e-mail, your name will appear in the From field of the outgoing message. Type your name as you would like it to appear.

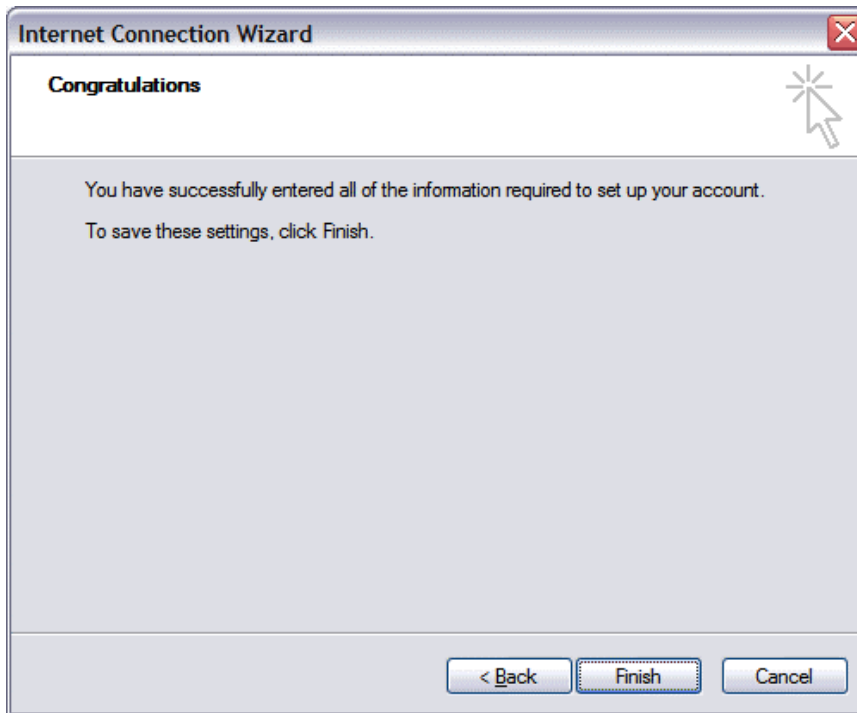

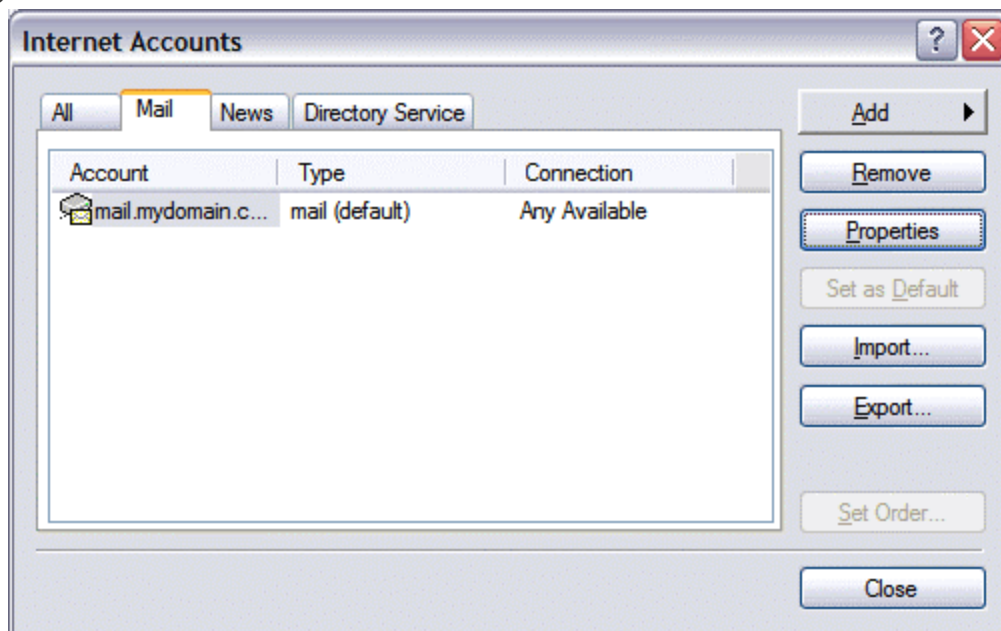
